Sir,

1. I am directed to refer to this Ministry's letter No. NHQ/PC/6304/01/1341/D(Pay/Services)/2008 dated 10 October, 2008 on the subject mentioned above read with SAI/SNI/SAFI 2/S/98 and to convey the sanction of the competent authority to re-exercise the date of next increment (DNI) option on promotion to the rank of Lt Col/equivalent retrospectively to the officers of the rank of Major/equivalent who were promoted to the grade during 1.3.1999 to 28.2.2000.


2. Consequent to the re-fixation of pay on account of the above re-exercise of DNI option, arrears of pay and allowances, if any, would be payable to the officers after adjustment of the emoluments already drawn.

3. The option shall be exercised in writing so as to reach the concerned Pay Accounts office within one hundred and eighty days from the date of issue of this letter.

Subject:-Removal of anomalies arising from the implementation of the revised pay scales and the allowances consequent to the recommendations of the V CPC/HLC - Implementation of pay scales of Major and equivalents.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to this Ministry's letter No.1(26)/97/II/D(Pay/Services) dated 29th February, 2000 on the subject mentioned above read with SAI/SNI/SAFI 2/S/98 and to convey the sanction of the President for stepping up of pay of the Officers of the rank of Major and equivalent whose pay on promotion to the rank of Major and equivalent was fixed at Rs.11,600/- in accordance with the aforementioned Army/Navy/Air Force instructions and who are drawing less pay than their juniors consequent on fixation of pay of the juniors on promotion to the rank of Major and equivalent at Rs.11925/- in accordance with the letter dated 29th February, 2000. The stepping up will be subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:-

- (a) Both the junior and the senior officers should be of the same rank and should belong to the same cadre/Service;
- (b) The pre-revised and revised scales of pay of the rank in which they are entitled to draw pay should be identical;
- (c) If even in the lower rank, the junior Officer was drawing more pay in the pre-revised scale than the senior by virtue of any advance increments granted to him, provision of this letter will not be invoked to step up the pay of the senior officer.

2. The stepping up of pay thus allowed would be further subject to the condition that the anomaly is directly as a result of the application of the provisions of MOD letter No. 1(26)/97/II/D(Pay/Ser) dated 29th February, 2000 referred to above.

3. The aforesaid stepping up of pay would be applicable to officers of the rank of Major/equivalent and promoted to the grade during 1.3.1999 to 28.2.2000.

4. This issues with the approval of Defence Secretary and with the concurrence of the Ministry of Defence (Finance) vide their Dy. No.558/AG/PA dated 1.10.2008.

Subject : Removal of anomalies arising from the implementation of the revised pay scales and allowances consequent to the V CPC recommendations - implementation of pay scales of Major and equivalents.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to Instructions No.SAI, SNI and SAI/I No.2/S/98 dated 19-12-1997 and Ministry of Defence letters No.1(5)/97/D(Pay/Services) dated 21st November, 1997 providing special dispensation for pay scales of Major and equivalent; and No.14(1)/98/D(AG) dated 14-1-2000 on the reduction of eligibility period for substantive promotion to the rank of Major and equivalent and to state that the issues regarding certain anomalies arising from the implementation of revised pay scales and allowances consequent to Fifth CPC award for the Defence Service personnel has since been considered by the Government in the light of the recommendations of a Committee specially constituted on the above subject and it has been decided that the pay of officers of three Services on promotion to the rank of Major and equivalent in a substantive capacity will be fixed initially at the stage of Rs.11925/- in the pay scale of Rs.11,600 - 325 - 14,850, in addition to rank pay.

2. The relevant Rules in Pay and Allowances Regulations for Army, Air Force and Navy will be suitably amended.
3. This will take effect from date of issue of this letter.
4. This issues with the concurrence of Ministry of Defence (Finance) vide their U.O. No.1/77/99-PA, dated 23-2-2000.
